#### **Minute Approval**

- August minutes approved by unanimous consent (there was no meeting in September)
- July, 2025 minutes were approved by unanimous consent

#### WROC 2025 Update (Andrew Faust - NCWRPC and Zach Nienow - Ayres)

- Agenda Notes:
  - Andy and Zach went over status of 2025 WROC
  - o 64 participating counties
  - o Data should be sent to partners in Feb/March 2026, statewide in March/April timeframe
  - Partners and NG911 grant data were a big part of success
  - o 2023/2024 high res data already delivered to partners
  - They will include a year on their status map and send to us.
  - Question: would it be easier if State Agencies had an annual aerial imager budget instead of big amounts every 5 years?
    - Some counties are flying in 2026-27 or 2028-30
  - Andy retiring in December
  - Early next year they will have a funding need projection
- Discussion Notes:
  - Question that runs into another topic... from Christine: what state border layer/buffer do you use? Ayres uses DNR state boundary and goes 500 feet beyond bnds.
